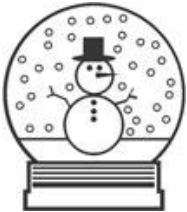

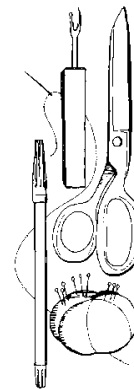

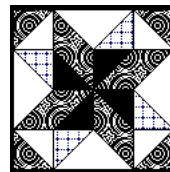
March - Fabric Challenge

Bring your finished Challenge piece to the March 4 meeting. We will be displaying and judging our favorites. If you can't attend be sure to send your piece with a friend. All pieces will be collected and held for the May Quilt Show where they will be hung together. You should have your name on the back and a commit-to-hang form filled out to register your quilt in the show.

April - Mystery Quilts

Bring these quilts, finished or not, to the April 1 meeting. We all want to see how this project turned out for everyone. Be sure to fill out a commit-to-hang form if you intend to have your quilt in the May Quilt Show. Mystery quilts should be identified on the form so that they all can hang together at the show.

Quilt Show Information

Remember all commit-to-hang forms must be filled out and submitted to Barbara Logan on or before the March 4 meeting. These can be done on the LAP website, www.lansingareapatchers.com Go to the top left corner of the home page, click on forms, and select a version of the form. At the bottom is the Online Version. This will allow you to fill out your information and submit your form

as one action. You will then get a confirmation print-out for your records.

Don't forget to turn in your UFO's to Shelly Winger. Be sure to fill out the UFO Rescue Inventory form to include with your packet. The form can be found on the website, or at the March meeting. Anything will do! Have just one block? Turn it in!! Have just pieces and parts? Turn them in!! Started a project and have decided it just ain't gonna happen? Turn it in!! We will sell these UFO's at the Quilt Show as a fund raiser for our favorite guild, LAP!!! Clean out your quilting tables and storage totes, you know you all have something to donate.

1. No sleeve necessary.
2. Attach a label in either lower corner of the quilt back.
3. Deliver the quilt in a pillowcase with a matching label.
4. Labels must have:
 - Your name
 - Quilt name
 - Quilt size
